

FREDERICK COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY ACCESS TO CARE PROGRAM

The Access to Care Program, funded in part by the Maryland Community Health Resources Commission, provides primary health care services for adults and children who are uninsured and have total household incomes at or below 200% of the federal poverty level, as adjusted for the size of the family.



The Access to Care Program is open to the public, but all persons must meet the income guidelines to be eligible for enrollment. The maximum fee charged is a \$5.00 co-payment per visit, but fees can be waived due to financial hardship; no one who is eligible for the program will be denied care due to an inability to pay the co-payment.
