



MEDICAL AND HEALTH CARE PROGRAMS OPERATED BY THE FREDERICK COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY

- **Health Care for the Homeless:** The Health Care for the Homeless (HCH) program provides primary health care and supportive services to people who are homeless. The FCAA operates a primary health care clinic that is staffed by nurse practitioners, physicians, medical assistants, and case managers.
- **Medical Assistance Provider:** The FCAA is a participating provider in the Maryland Medical Assistance (Medicaid) Program and is currently accepting both adult and pediatric patients that have active Medical Assistance and have enrolled with Maryland Physicians Care MCO or Priority Partners MCO. The FCAA also accepts patients with Unrestricted Medical Assistance.
- **Access to Care Program:** Funded in part by the Maryland Community Health Resources Commission, the Access to Care (ATC) Program provides primary health care services for adults and children who are uninsured, ineligible for other health care programs, and have a total household income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level (FPL), as adjusted for the size of the family.
- **Medbank Program:** Through the Medbank Program, FCAA case managers and outreach workers help people to access free prescription medications made available through patient assistance programs operated by pharmaceutical manufacturing companies.

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
