POLICE REPORT:

Sgt. Pue, Cpl. Snyder & Det. Putman was in attendance to talk about the police statistics as well as address any issues and concerns. Sgt. Pue said that crime as a whole is down and addressed a few issues brought up in the Lord Nickens area.

- Residents had emailed him about a teen running around with what looked to be a gun, it was a toy gun and FPD is following up with the family.
- There was a substance on the door of Guidos that looked like blood what was it? It was fake blood for an event they were having.
- Kid on roof of Café 611 – no report taken so they either could not find him or found the parents.
- Teen ran outside with a gun during a dog fight – this was never called in.

Detective Putman talked about the shots fired incidents and said that witnesses are not being too cooperative and that they did do a search warrant on a suspect (warrant was for another reason). He said they are still actively working on leads.

Cpl. Snyder said there has been some progress – the dirt pile is gone and the trees were trimmed on Emma Smith Alley. He reminded residents to please call if they see something. Residents asked Cpl. Description: Applicant proposes to subdivide Lot 4 into two lots 4A and 4B. The property is zoned DB downtown business and in the historic district overlay. Lot 4A is proposed for commercial/office uses; and lot 4B has no prospective use and is sized to accommodate the most intensive use permitted on the lot, i.e. multi-family or mixed uses.

Chief Pouget and Lisa were on hand to introduce themselves to the community and to talk about services that DFRS offers. They are interested in attending more community events. They also reminded residents that October is Fire Prevention Month and many of the local fire departments will be hosting open houses!

Meaghan Tarquinio - - Heartly House 24 hour # 301-662-8800

Heartly House is here in downtown Frederick and offers a variety of services for victims of domestic violence. Some of these services include: 24 hour hotline, crisis intervention, counseling services, hospital accompaniment, legal services, crisis shelter, community education, abuser intervention program, and transitional housing.

The shelter has 267 beds in 7 rooms and they are like apartments but share a kitchen. Meaghan said that 1 in 4 women and 1 in 7 men, will be the victim of domestic violence. She encouraged people with questions to please call the above #.

There are 2 events coming up that will benefit Heartly House: Evening on the Rivera: October 3, 2014 and Walk a Mile: October 11, 2014

Tim Davis & Alderman Kelly Russell– The City of Frederick Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee

Tim and Kelly were on hand to give an update on the committee.

- Pump track – The pump track off of East Street has been seeing a lot of traffic from folks of all ages.
- High Wheel Race was a great success and there was a large turnout. There are only 4 high wheel races in the world and this one is the only one in the Unites States.
- East Street Rails & Trails project has been started
- Construction for the crossing under US 15 will begin this spring. This will connect Waterford & Baker Park and provide 6 miles without having to share with traffic of shared use space.
- The History Loop has 23 different sites to stop at and has become an attraction in Frederick
- Bike sharing program is on hold for now until results from other areas can be evaluated.

The entrance will be opening in May 2015 as part of their ongoing construction project to improve access to the hospital. There is currently an alley named Emma Smith and Emergency Services requires that FMH cannot use the same name as an existing roadway. FMH would like the alley way renamed. A resident is informally collecting a response from residents of North Point and will respond to the hospital with any suggestions.
