POLICE REPORT:

Sgt. Beliveau was on hand to talk about any concerns or issues and to review the crime statistics below. He said there is a black male who has exposed himself 5 times since the end of last year. He said the victims are white females between the ages of 24-26. He also said there were 2 residential burglaries on East Third Street. There is a suspect identified in those cases. Patrol is addressing a noise complaint at Old Towne Tavern and residents are encouraged to call if they have a noise complaint.

A resident said that there has been a concern of someone loosening lug nuts on East Third Street and it was posted to their Facebook page.

PLANNING:

East Frederick Small Area Plan – Jeff Love

Jeff was on hand to talk with residence about the East Frederick Small Area Plan. The Planning Department will be putting out a survey in the next month or so asking for input from residents.

GUEST SPEAKERS:

Cullar Lake Update – Michael Paskowsky

Michael was on hand to give residents an update about Phase 1 and 2 for the Culler Lake restoration. He said that Phase 1 is funded by the City of Frederick and should begin later this year. Phase 1 consists of dredging the lake, which is estimated to take 500 truck loads. Also consists of creating 3 gravel wetlands which will encourage organisms to grow, a mechanical system to pre-treat the water, new fountain 10-15 ft in height with LED lights, new pathways and boardwalk. The estimated cost for this is 1M.

Phase 2 is the master plan for the rest of the area and is still in concept stage. Residents are encouraged to submit ideas to Friends of Baker Park.
