Project Name: Monocacy Gateway
Location: 801 E. Church Street
COF Staff: Pam Reppert 301-600-1718
Applicant: Clustered Spires Property Company LLC
Description: The Applicant is seeking to rezone the 77 acre property from Light Industrial and General Commercial to Mixed Use. The property is also in the Airport Overlay zoning district due to its proximity to the Frederick Municipal Airport.

The sketch concept for the Master Plan depicts a maximum potential of 600 multifamily dwelling units, 330 townhouse units, and 150,000 sf of retail and commercial space. This project is still in the preliminary stages.

GUEST SPEAKER

Caitlin McIntire – Downtown Frederick Partnership

Caitlin was on hand to talk about Fire & Ice. She said the event was very successful. They do realize that there were some challenges and that parking was an issue. She said that they worked closely with the police and will be meeting with them to discuss some after-action items for next year. She anticipated 25-30 thousand people attended this year's event. Residents expressed concern about traffic control, trash and vandalism of ice sculptures.

Keith Brown, Mike Winpigler, Chip Stitley, & Zack Fleagle – Department of Public Works

The DPW folks were on hand to answer any questions regarding DPW. They talked about snow removal and why the downtown area was not done curb to curb. They also discussed some challenges faced during this storm and also thanked the residents for removing their cars from the street. Mike Winpigler said there were 3000 loads of snow removed from the downtown area!
