I. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Department of Public Works endeavors to remove the snow and ice from the streets of the City of Frederick to provide a safe driving surface to its users.

The Department of Public Works will also remove snow and ice from City owned parking lots and parking decks, sidewalks at City facilities, sidewalks on City bridges, and other City facilities.

Listed below are the phases with which the snow removal plan will operate:

Phase I	Salting (treatment of roads with salt)
Phase II	Emergency Routes (plowing of snow emergency routes only)
Phase III	Collector Streets (plowing of snow on collector streets within the city)
Phase IV	Hauling/Clean-Up (hauling of snow within the downtown area and other areas as necessary)
Phase V	Recovery (final clean-up of problem areas as necessary)

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF CITIZENS DURING SNOW EVENT

Below is a list of responsibilities for citizens during a snow event. This information will help citizens better understand what they are responsible for and it will also assist DPW in providing efficient and safe snow removal during snow events.

- When a snow emergency is declared it will be announced via local radio broadcasts, telecasts and the City website at www.cityoffrederick.com. In addition, we will have a recorded message on the City Emergency Information Line at 301-600-1300.
- Parking on snow emergency routes is prohibited starting two (2) hours after the snow emergency declaration. Please remove all vehicles within the required time.
- Prohibited parking shall remain in effect until the snow emergency has been lifted. Cars in violation may be towed at owner's expense.
- Vehicles traveling on snow emergency routes are required to have snow tires or chains.
- Within 12 hours after the snow stops falling, a person owning or occupying a lot, or part of a lot, abutting a City sidewalk shall remove the snow and ice from the abutting sidewalk for a width of 4 feet, or the width of the sidewalk, whichever is less.
- If the owner or occupant fails to remove the snow and ice a Code Enforcement official shall place a "Notice of Violation" in a conspicuous place on the property notifying the property owner or occupant to remove the snow and ice.
- If the property owner fails to comply with the "Notice of Violation" within twenty-four (24) hours after its posting, the Code Enforcement official may cause the snow and ice to be removed. The costs of removal will be charged to the property owner. (Ref. City of Frederick Charter Sec. 22.16)
- It is unlawful for any person to place and/or deposit snow in or upon any street, sidewalks or other public ways. *Violators of this is declared to be a municipal infraction. The penalty for*

violation shall be the sum up to five-hundred dollars (\$500.00). (Ref. City of Frederick Charter Sec. 22-16.1)



