



NAC 3 Meeting Minutes Monday, September 12, 2016 Monocacy Elementary School

Attendance: 34 Residents and Alderman Michael O'Connor.

POLICE REPORT:

Sgt. Carrado and Officer Brian Lucas were in attendance. Sgt. Carrado spoke of many thefts from cars in Amber Meadows over the summer by small groups of youths who look for open doors and take what they find. He stressed that this is not just happening in Amber Meadows, though. He offered that if residents would lock their doors (car and house doors) crime in the City would be reduced by 30%. There was a lot of input and questions from the audience. He also spoke of the epidemic of overdoses in the City, mainly on heroin. He pointed out that this is a nationwide epidemic, not just occurring in Frederick. He noted that there are members of gangs in Frederick and mentioned many of the steps that the FPD take to educate children in particular of the dangers of gangs. There was a lot of input and questions from the audience on these topics, as well. He mentioned that there are nine recruits in the current Police Academy that are slated for the FPD and that they will be knocking on the doors of residents, seeking their input on better policing. He mentioned the upcoming Coffee with a Cop event. Finally, the Sgt. introduced Officer Brian Lucas as the new daytime officer for our NAC area. His number is 301-600-1222.

PLANNING:

GUEST SPEAKERS:

Code Enforcement: NAC 3 Code Enforcement officer Dave Beers and Brittney Parks, Brittany Parks

- Acting Division Manager of Code Enforcement — **There were** 15,000 violations this year across the City, mainly about grass/weeds, tree trimming and trash removal. The Department has five inspectors who are assigned to specific NACs; Dave Beers is assigned to NAC 3. There is a new website to report violations: spires2.cityoffrederick.com/codeenforcement/codecomplaint/. There were a lot of questions from the audience on the work of the Department.

OLD BUSINESS:

NAC 3 Board Vice President Beth Conny opened the meeting introducing the other Board members. She asked the audience to raise their hands indicating in which neighborhood they live. She shared some news about ongoing developments in the NAC, mentioning that the painting of the Northside Water Tower continues and that the project will complete in October. Last, she noted that the Monocacy Blvd overpass is on schedule and will complete in Spring 2018.
