Dan Hoffman – Manager Code Enforcement

Zack and Dan were on hand to talk about Code Enforcement as well as to answer any questions. Dan went over the code enforcement #'s as well as where people can find information. He also said that people can report violations online and can be done anonymously. In NAC 11 they have had 394 violations year to date and 266 cases. Dan specifically went over a couple of addresses in the area and provided updates.

Dan said that he wants to start meeting bi-weekly with 2 NAC 11 Coordinators to provide updates on problem properties in the area. He will get with the Coordinators to start the meetings.

The Vacant & Blighted Committee will be presenting at the Workshop on Wednesday, July 20th at 3:00 pm. The Workshop is televised and can be watched online as well.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Market & E. 2nd Street (by Edgeworks) – there is a “One Way” sign and residents would like another added or the current sign moved to the other side of the road. **COMPLETED**

NEW BUSINESS:

- Alley concerns-Chapel Alley between 2nd & 3rd Street – can they get a speed limit sign? Several additional concerns were raised about Maxwell and Chapel Alleys in general-traffic speed limits -25 MPH is too fast for these congested and tight road and pedestrian ways which also have parked cars and garages on them. **The lowest speed in the City of Frederick (non-school zone) is 25 mph.**
- Pedestrian concerns-as mentioned above the alleys are of concern with speeding traffic through close roadways. Lack of consistent crosswalks throughout downtown- example- crossings at all numbered streets and Church while walking Maxwell and Chapel Alleys. Frederick has become a very busy pedestrian city but concerns for safety and infrastructure need to be updated and improved.
- Status and future of the Visitation property on East Church and East Second Streets? Can we ask Mr. Matan to address NAC 11 with plans?
