1. August 6 minutes were approved
2. Jenny Willoughby provided an update on In the Street. The Committee will have a table at the event and all shifts have been covered. The display will be the same focus as the one at the Green Neighbor Festival.
3. Partnerships discussion was tabled until Christine could be at the meeting.
4. The draft recommendation letter to request clarification and update the City Code for who is responsible for litter pick up was edited to include a request to send a response in writing and correct the Committee's first letter date to February 6 instead of February 8.
  - a. The Committee voted to approve the letter with amendments.
5. Project Proposal for joint project with County recycling

- a. Mark Broski proposed a project that focused on new stickers for recycling bins to show what should be recycled.
  - b. Dewey Stewart proposed an art project that he developed with Emily Roy. He made the point that public art can have a major impact on the community and that their project would focus on reducing waste rather than recycling better. He also said that the funding could be matched with grant funds.
  - c. Voting for the project was delayed until next meeting when more members could be present.
6. Mark presented some information about Carbon Neutral 2050 and stated that it was out of the bounds of the Committee and would take a major commitment from the City, including significant staff changes and funding.
