1. October and November minutes approved.
2. Climate Action Plan Update
Representatives from ICF presented the DRAFT Climate Action Plan in full to the Committee, including why the City is working on developing a plan, crosswalking with existing plans, GHG footprint, identifying climate actions the City plans to adopt, assess and explain climate risks that the City may face, and provide recommendations for climate-resilient strategies.
3. Update from Climate Emergency Workgroup
Barb Trader from the Climate Emergency Workgroup presented to the group regarding what the City/County joint efforts are in the workgroup. The group is called Mobilize Frederick, not run by elected officials, but citizen-led. The group that is leading the workgroup knew about the City and County operations, but wanted to drive more action at the City and County level and throughout the community. About 60 people are involved in the committee with four sub-groups: Energy, Building, and Transportation, Carbon Sequestration, Adaptation and Resilience, and Community Awareness and

Outreach. Mid-term report due in February 2021 and final report due September 2021.
