Katey explained the purpose of tonight's meeting is to determine specific projects from the Climate Emergency Mobilization Work Group final report that the Committee might bring forward to Mayor and Board of Alderman with a funding request or develop a specific project that committee members might take on.

Mobilize Frederick transition team presented some actions that the committee might take on. Marketing, communication, and outreach seemed to be the biggest factor to getting participation in the existing programs and in new programs.

Mobilize Frederick identified several priorities for the immediate future. Top priorities are communications and establishment of a green bank for residents for projects like home energy retrofits. Expansion of solar, microgrids, home energy improvements, and building performance standards, food security, and composting are priorities as well.
