Description: The subject property is located at 633 Medimmune Court within the existing production facility on Solarex Court. The site is zoned Light Industrial, M1 and is located in the Highway Noise Overlay. The purpose of the site plan is to relocate the cooling towers from the roof to an elevated

support structure. There will be 12 piers for the support structure. The cooling towers will be 22 ft. tall included a 4 ft. handrail.

Boys & Girls Club looking to make Burck Street for middle and high school students and empty Lincoln A building would be used for elementary school students. During the day, the school will be used for the Success program and then Boys & Girls Club in the evening.

The other program that would be housed there is the Child Find program. This program offers services for youth as young as 3 years old. This space will be for their office staff. Renovations will begin this summer. The site will be renovated and will have custodial staff. The programs will start in September.

Michele Bowman explained last night that a) it is labor intensive; as it would have to be collected separately b) if any trash is thrown in recycle bin, the entire collection is put into the “trash” stream. The county does not take the time to weed out trash versus recycles. Not feasible at this point.
