- **Officer Margery Lee – School Safety Talk**
 - Bicycle safety
It is very important to have a properly fitted helmet. Make sure it is tight. Make sure bicycle is proper size and in good working order (tires, brakes, reflectors, etc.). Good idea to wear reflective colors. Strobe lights are another good item to attach to the bike and person. Go with the flow of traffic - obey traffic laws. Bikes are allowed on most city sidewalks, except the downtown area.
 - School bus safety - Stay 6 feet away from curb, it is not a place for running or playing. Adult supervision is helpful at bus stops. Never walk behind a school bus and that you are visible at all times. For adults driving, never pass a school bus. FPD has a grant for school bus enforcement.
 - Bullying - If there is an issue, they can contact the school.
